Web Sites For Immigration Research

>Irish immigration - <http://www.famineships.info/>

Searchable database of records on over half a million passengers who arrived in the U.S. between 1846 thru 1851 and identified their country of origin as Ireland or ethnicity as Irish. Records of passengers who were U.S. citizens or non-U.S. citizens planning to continue their travels, returning to the U.S., or staying in the U.S. Records of passengers arriving at the following ports: Baltimore, Boston, Philadelphia, New Orleans, and (primarily) New York.

>**Finnish Immigrants** - <http://www.finnishimmigrants.org/>

Searchable database covering the same as the Irish Immigration site. Records on approximately 25,000 passengers who arrived in the U.S. between 1834 thru 1897.

>**Italian Immigrants** - <http://www.italianimmigrants.org/>

Searchable database for over half a million passengers arriving in the U.S, between 1855 thru 1900. Other info the same as above.

>**Russian Immigrants Records: 1834-1897** - <http://www.rusianimmigrants.org/>

Searchable database covering ports the same as above, for over half a million passengers who arrived in the U.S. and identified their country of origin or nationality as Armenia, Finland, Galicia, Lithuania, Poland, Russian Poles, or Ukraine.

>**19th Century Polish Immigrants** - <http://www.polishimigration.org/>

Searchable database on approximately 90,000 passengers arriving in the U.S, between 1834 thru 1897. Ports of arrival same as above.

>**Asian Immigrants - [Historic Ship Passenger Lists]** <https://familysearch.org/search/collection/1916081>

FamilySearch.org has indexed some 360,000 passenger ship records for Seattle, WA. These are passenger and crew lists that arrived in Seattle between 1890 to 1957. A typical record lists the name, age, sex, marital status, occupation, and citizenship of individuals - as well as details on the ship; such as, name of ship and date of arrival. Some records also list last permanent address and final destination. Many of the ships that docked in Seattle during this time period had come from Asia. This is a good record set to search for anyone who had ancestors who migrated from Japan. These records can be searched by name and access is free.

>**German Immigration/German Immigration Records** <https://familysearch.org/search/collection/2110801>

Record collection of some 4.1 million records of Germans who migrated to America between 1850 -1897. These records come from the Balch Institute for Ethnic Studies. Key information found in these records is name, age, sex, last residence in Germany, and expected town/city destination in the U.S. Access is free.

The family History Library staff have now completed a project to improve the Pennsylvania section of FamilySearchWiki. Special emphasis has been placed on the county pages. Users will find lots of links to online church records, naturalizations, and wills. On this guide are a series of research articles packed with ideas for tracing ancestors in big cities like Philadelphia and Pittsburgh as well as 67 counties throughout the state. Church records are a valuable source of research in Pennsylvania as vital records are not generally available before the mid 1800s. A great deal of effort has been made to determine which church records are available online at sites such as Ancestry, FamilySearch, and USGenWeb. EUREKA!

For several years now I have wanted to know more about my mother's maternal grandmother, Elizabeth Davenport Kessler Judd. I know a few things. She was born about 1863 in Kentucky. She married William P. Kessler in 1883, and they were the parents of three children. In 1890 Elizabeth became the third wife of Nathaniel Judd, my mother's maternal grandfather, and bore him five children, including my grandmother. This family appears in the 1900 census for Green County, KY. Nathaniel died 14 July 1908, and in the 1910 census for this area, the young children of Nathaniel and Elizabeth are all living with relatives. I assume she has died, but official death records for the state of Kentucky don't begin till 1911. Various attempts to discover more about her death have been unsuccessful. My mother's younger brother, David, and his wife (who is the family historian) agreed to meet me in Kentucky for some research. We arrived late Sunday afternoon, June 9, 2013, and planned to start work early the next morning, (One interesting note -- our motel was in Campbellsville, which is on Eastern time, while the library was 10 miles away in Greensburg and on Central time).

We arrived at the county clerk's office when the doors opened at 7:30 a.m., "slow time". Here we found books of marriage records, easily accessible and organized by date. The deputy clerk set us up in a little office so we could spread out these books and allowed us to use the copy machine. We were excited to discover the bond for Nathaniel Judd's first marriage, dated 14 December 1857, as well as my grandparents and many others. While we knew the dates of these marriages, seeing the official record was thrilling. Later, we crossed the street to the county library, which has an excellent collection of books and family files for people in this area. We found obituaries for many relatives, pictures of some, cemetery listings, and more. Things we hadn't seen online. But, there was nothing about the elusive Elizabeth Judd. As the library was closing, rain began to pour down and we were notified that the area was under a tornado watch. We waited until all was clear before driving back to the motel. After dinner we looked through our notes and thought about what else to look for.

Tuesday we returned to the clerk's office for more marriage records and examined county order books. These are the notes of what happened at the monthly court meetings. Sandra Goren wrote on her website, "Here you will find references to Revolutionary War pension applications, naming of administrators for individuals who died without a will, note of executorships...it's important to look at these books!" I thought perhaps Nathaniel died intestate and there might be some reference here about Elizabeth. I took the book for 1907-1909 and opened to July 1908, when he died. Nothing in July, but soon we were doing the happy dance!

For the court session dated 7 October 1908 we found this: "It is ordered by the court that Elizabeth Judd and her five infant children be and they are hereby declared paupers for Green County, Ky, and that the said Elizabeth Judd be and she is hereby allowed the sum of five (5) dollars per month from this day until the next April term 1909 of the Green County Fiscal Court, and D. K. Creamer will expend said amount or said Judd & children and he will report same to said fiscal court." Could this be our Elizabeth? Certainly this fits with what we know, ours had five children under 21, and D. K. Creamer was a relative. So we jumped ahead to the next court session and found a similar decision in the April term 1909. But there was nothing in October 1909.

Since we know that the oldest child, Cora Mae, married 10 October 1909, and that the younger ones are living with relatives in the 1910 census report (including one with Cora and her new husband), we feel fairly confident that Elizabeth had died between 24 April 1909 and October 1909. There were (and still are) lots of Judds in Green County, and Elizabeth is a common name, but for now we believe we may have solved part of the mystery surrounding my great-grandmother Judd. When we went to the Judd cemetery Tuesday afternoon, we saw two broken-off stones, one on either side of Nathaniel's. We like to think that one of them is Elizabeth's and the other is for their child who died at age three.

MONO COUNTY, CALIFORNIA - A Thumbnail Sketch

A county in the east central portion of California. East of the Sierra Nevada and between Yosemite National Park and the state of Nevada. As of the 2000 census, the population was 14,202 inhabitants. The county seat is located in Bridgeport. Mammoth Lakes is the only incorporated town in the state.

Mono County is riddled with old mines and proud of its Native American history. Here you will also find some lovely vacation and recreation destinations; such as, Mammoth Lakes at the foot of Mammoth Mountain and June Lake. Other places of interest are the official gold rush ghost town of Bodie, now a California State Historic Park, and Mono Lake, with its pinnacles of tufa arising out of the salty, alkaline waters, and a vital habitat for millions of migrating and nesting birds.

Mono County was formed in 1861 from parts of Calaveras, Fresno and Mariposa counties. Portions of Mono County were later given to Inyo County in 1863.
